

**FOURTH STREET CROSSING METROPOLITAN DISTRICT
2024 ANNUAL REPORT
TOWN OF SILVERTHORNE, SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO**

Pursuant to Section VII of the Service Plan (“Service Plan”) of the Fourth Street Crossing Metropolitan District (the “District”) and pursuant to Section 32-1-207(3)(c), C.R.S., the District is required to provide an Annual Report (“Annual Report”) to the Clerk of the Town of Silverthorne no later than September 1st of each year. The District hereby submits the following Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 2024 (the “Reporting Year”).

1. A narrative summary of the progress of the District in implementing its Service Plan for the Reporting Year.

The public improvements have been completed in accordance with the Service Plan.

2. Except when exemption from audit has been granted for the Reporting Year under the Local Government Audit Law, the audited financial statements of the District for the Reporting Year, including a statement of financial condition (i.e., balance sheet) as of December 31st of the Reporting Year and the statement of operations (i.e., revenues and expenditures) for the Reporting Year.

No capital expenditures incurred during the Reporting Year, as the Fourth Street Crossing Business Improvement District is responsible for financing, constructing, and installing the public facilities. The construction of remaining capital improvements continued through coordination with the Fourth Street Crossing Business Improvement District the last five years.

In 2019, the District entered into a Capital Pledge Agreement with Fourth Street Crossing Business Improvement District whereby the District has pledged the revenue it receives from its debt service mill levy to payment of the Fourth Street Crossing Business

Improvement District's 2019 Bonds. Fourth Street Crossing Business Improvement District entered into that certain Assignment of Property Tax Revenues on May 25, 2022 with the Fourth North Business Improvement District whereby it agreed to assign the property tax revenues it receives from the District to the payment of the Fourth North Business Improvement District 2022 Bonds.

5. A summary of residential and commercial development in the District for the Reporting Year.

In coordination with the Fourth Street Crossing Business Improvement District, residential and commercial development is complete within the District's boundaries in 2023.

6. A summary of all fees, charges, and assessments imposed by the District as of January 1st of the Reporting Year.

There were no fees, charges, or assessments imposed by the District as of January 1st of the Reporting Year.

7. Certification of the Board of Directors that no action, event or condition enumerated in Section 4-10-5 of the Silverthorne Charter and Municipal Code has occurred in the Reporting Year.

The Board certifies that no actions, events, or conditions enumerated in Section 4-10-5 of the Silverthorne Charter and Municipal Town Code occurred in 2024.
